Location	Siphofaneni (Damsite)
Reporting to:	Potable Water Technician
Objective:	Responsible for water meter reading program; reads residential and commercial water meters; ensures quality customer service to consumers; and performs minor water meter maintenance.
Duties and Responsibilities	 Read residential and commercial water meters with computerized hand-held machine; read meters manually as necessary; record readings making necessary calculations. Assist with field testing of customer meters for accuracy. Perform minor field repairs; replace damaged meter boxes and lids; clean out meter boxes; check for meter leaks. Perform customer service duties including service turn-ons and turn-offs, rereading meters to resolve complaints, and notify customers of water interruptions and of the type of work to be performed. Perform related duties as required.
Qualifications, Skills, Experience	 Formal or informal education or training which ensures the ability to read and write at a level necessary for successful job performance. Some experience reading, maintaining, and repairing/replacing water meters is desirable. Operational characteristics of meter reading devices and related tools and equipment. Uses and purposes of general construction tools and equipment. Principles and practices of customer service. Basic mathematical principles. Principles and practices of record keeping. Occupational hazards and standard safety practices.
